



ARES-Manitoba Monthly Readiness Net for 2010

This ARES net observes "local time" always at **4 pm Manitoba time**. ARES-Manitoba will continue with once-monthly ARES readiness nets, on the **4th Sunday** or alternate date in **each month**, until further notice.

Schedule

3:50 pm to 4:00 pm: station propagation checks, prior to the 'Net call-in.

4:00 pm to ~ 4:20 pm: Main Net is on 7,075 KHz LSB (+/- QRM)

4:00 pm to ~ 4:15 pm: Regional Sub-Nets are on 3,675 KHz LSB.

Please use the sub-net plan for these nets if you cannot hear the Main Net Control Station. All sub-net control stations please report to the Main Net Control Station with sub-net check-ins' callsigns and communities represented.

If you are not equipped for HF, please try one of the existing repeaters to reach the MNCS.

For IRLP, connect to reflector 9003 in Vancouver.
